Two of our favourite Canadian bands are teaming up for a not-to-be-missed concert at Darke Hall. **Elliott BROOD** is a three-piece Folk, Rock, Alt, Country band based in Hamilton. Their meticulously crafted albums have garnered some of

Canada's highest musical honours including the Polaris Music Prize Short List and a Juno Award. The music of **Great Lake Swimmers** features a blend of acoustic instruments, rural landscapes, and beautiful vocals. They too were short-listed for the Polaris Prize and were twice nominated for the Juno Awards. CBC calls them a national treasure.

Green Thumb Theatre's **The Shape of a Girl** challenges audiences to interrogate their capacity to both help and harm others and to be brave when standing up for what is right. As relevant as ever, Green Thumb Theatre premiered *The Shape of a Girl* over 20 years ago, and the piece has since gone on to hundreds of productions worldwide. This is a powerful production that is a must-see for adults and teens.

Teagan Littlechief is a dynamic country rock artist with a voice that captivates and a spirit that inspires. Known for her powerhouse vocals and commanding stage presence, Teagan is one of Canada's leading Indigenous musicians.

She is the 2025 SaskMusic Contemporary Indigenous Artist of the Year, the 2024 SCMA Female Artist of the Year, and is a three-time SCMA Indigenous Artist of the Year recipient.

Ridge • April 8 & 9, 2026



Often called the “battle that made Canada,” Vimy Ridge resulted in over 10,000 Canadian casualties. Through storytelling and live music, **The Fugitives** examine misconceptions and varying perspectives around the battle, while drawing parallels to other formative events in our nation’s past. The songs from *Ridge* were nominated for the 2022 JUNO for Best Traditional Roots Album. A vivid, kinetic ride through history, as well as an intimate, personal examination of our connection to the past, *Ridge* is a visceral work that passionately argues against the exploitation of young lives.

Delhi 2 Dublin • May 1, 2026



For nearly two decades, **Delhi 2 Dublin** has been at the forefront of South Asian fusion music, pioneering a global bass sound they call “Subcontinental Pop”—a high-energy blend of Bhangra, electronic, hip-hop, reggae, and Celtic influences that defies genre. As they approach their 20th anniversary in 2026, the band continues to push their sound and vision to new heights, leading them into an exciting new chapter of music-making after a six-year hiatus.

WELCOME TO DARKE HALL, SITUATED ON TREATY 4 LANDS.

These are the territories of the nêhiyawak, Anihšīnapek, Dakota, Lakota, and Nakoda, and the homeland of the Métis/ Michif Nation.

Today, these lands continue to be the shared Territory of many diverse peoples from near and far. The nêhiyawak originally referred to Regina as *oskana ka-asasteki* which literally means "The place where bones are piled up."

This is what led to Regina's nickname "Pile O'Bones" and the origin of the name for Wascana Park, the location of Darke Hall.
